

In January 2015, Medicare authorized new CPT Code 99490, also known as the Chronic Care Management code (CCM), for \$42.60 to be paid monthly to doctors whose staff spend 20 minutes or more monitoring or coordinating care for Medicare patients with two or more chronic diseases.

ChronicCareIQ converts patients' smart phones into powerful monitoring devices that enable them to update your office on their status in seconds. Patients answer standard diagnostic questions on their smart phone, and their responses are updated on a color coded dashboard in real-time. Your clinical team is automatically alerted if a patient is trending poorly or passes clinical thresholds that you set.


